

# WNSL ADULT AWARDS

## **A. Coaches Hall of Fame Award**

1. Given yearly to a deserving coach who has shown a long time commitment to the coaching of High School or Middle School athletes.
2. A call for nominations is made in the fall by the League officers via email to the League members.
3. Any WNSL member may nominate a coach for this award which includes a short description of why they believe the person is a good candidate.
4. The League officers distribute the names of the candidates and short biographies to the members.
5. An electronic vote is taken to determine the recipient for that year.
6. The recipients picture and a write-up is placed in the State Meet Program
7. The League provides an award for the individual to keep
8. The recipient's name is placed on the traveling WNSL Coaches Hall of Fame plaque which the recipient can keep for the year.
9. The recipient is recognized at the State Meet Awards dinner and their picture and write-up is added to the list on the WNSL website.

## **B. Life Commitment Award**

1. This Award was meant to recognize those individuals who have made substantial contributions to the Nordic Ski Community at large. (It has been given posthumously as well as to living individuals)
2. The Organizing Committee of the State Meet determines if they wish to give this award – suggestions from WNSL members are welcome. This is not an automatic annual award.
3. The Organizing Committee determines the type of award to give.
4. The award is presented at the State Meet Awards dinner.
5. The recipient's year, name, and location (i.e. city) are listed on the WNSL website

## **C. Volunteer Award**

1. The Chip Wulff Award is given to individuals to recognize their long term commitment to volunteerism to the Nordic Ski Community. Recipients can come from any part of the state.
2. The Chip Wulff plaque is housed at winter Park in Minocqua.
3. The Organizing Committee of the State Meet determines if they wish to give this award – suggestions from WNSL members are welcome. This is not an automatic annual award.
4. The award is presented at the State Meet Awards dinner.
5. The recipient's year, name, and location (i.e. city) are listed on the plaque and on the WNSL website
